## Registration for Ph. D. Course Work 2010

The course work for the Ph. D. students of this Institute will start tentatively in 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> week of January 2010. The course work will comprise two semesters. The second semester will start on July 2010. Each semester will have 56 lectures, each of about 90 minutes duration. 1<sup>st</sup> semester Classes will be during Mon, Tue, Thu and Fri. Examinations will be held in **May** and **November 2010** respectively.

The organization of the first semester courses is as follows. There will be three compulsory courses (computer applications, statistical analysis and instrumental techniques) required for students of all disciplines, and one basic Biology/chemistry course (chemistry for biologists and biology for chemists) required for students of specific disciplines i.e. biology or chemistry.

The second semester will be devoted to advanced courses i.e. advanced biology, advanced chemistry and interdisciplinary courses.

A minimum of 80% attendance in these classes is required for all the students. Research Fellows who have recently joined the Ph. D. program and who have not fulfilled the course work requirement are also advised to fill out the registration form, the format of which is given below, and submit it to Dr. Siddhartha Majumdar, Head, HRG(Academic Affairs).
